Dear Second Amendment Supporter,

Chief Krajenka is breaking the law!

It has been brought to our attention that New Boston Police Chief Krajenka has taken it upon himself to ignore state law that says only the application form that the state police have written may be used.

You see, he apparently feels that he can re-write the law.

The legislature declared that your privacy is important and you cannot be required to give your phone or social security number in order to get a concealed carry license, but Chief Krajenka requires this in New Boston.

This is unacceptable.

If that isn't bad enough, he refuses to protect the privacy of the three references required on the state pistol license form, by requiring them to disclose their private information as well. He has declared that these references cannot be family; again he has put his wishes above the law.

He is also requiring New Boston residents to pay a fee upon applying for their license. NH law only allows a charge for "licenses issued".

The New Hampshire Firearms Coalition has asked to be put on the selectmen's meeting agenda, to make the selectmen aware of his violations of the pistol license law.

We need you to contact them as well.

His propensity to make his own rules reared its ugly head again when he recently threatened to arrest a very well respected firearms dealer in Manchester. Manchester Firing Line

owner, Jim McLoud, stores firearms at his business for many other police departments when those firearms are removed from a person subject to a protective order.

Imagine Jim's surprise when Krajenka barges into his business demanding firearms that were consigned to him months before the previous owner was served a protective order.

You see, under federal law the firearms left for consignment were transferred to Mr. McLoud and logged into his possession and can only be transferred to another person if that person can pass a background check. There was absolutely no way the firearms could have been transferred back to the previous owner while he had a protective order against him.

When this was explained to Chief Krajenka he became rude, indignant, and very unprofessional. That is just not the way upstanding NH citizens should be treated.

After all that, he refused to produce the court order that he alleged gave him the authority to take the firearms.

At best Krajenka used extremely bad judgment, and it is very possible he broke the law again.

Jim has filed in court to get his wrongly taken firearms back.

This should never have happened.

Now you will have to expend your hard earned tax dollars on lawyers to remedy this situation.

Please contact your selectmen and tell them enough is enough. Please fill out the enclosed petition, return it to us and we will deliver them to the selectmen.

Chief Krajenka needs to be reminded that he is a servant of the people and not their master. He needs to know that he is subject to the rule of law just like everyone else.

The town elections are coming up soon, and elected officials like selectmen are carefully listening to their constituents most clearly at this time.

Now is the time to make your voice heard. Let the selectmen know they need to reign in Chief Krajenka. Make sure

they know that you will not tolerate this outrageous behavior from those who are supposed to be serving the people.
